

Make your own Enchanted Rose

Materials needed:

- Printable template (see next page)
- Coloured paper or coloured pens
- Cardboard
- Plastic pint glass
- Scissors
- Cocktail stick

- Nail or point to make a hole
- Fishing line or dental floss (approximately 25cm)
- Clear bead (optional)

Instructions:























For the Rose petals:

- Print the template either on coloured paper, or on white and colour in.
- Cut on the dotted lines.
- Wrap the section of two petals around the cocktail stick and
- Tape the remaining petals closed by matching the edges.
- Using a pencil, curl the edges of each petal downward.
- Tie the fishing line to the base of the cocktail stick petals.
- Nest the petal circles inside of each other putting the cocktail stick petal in the centre.

For the Stem:

- Using the template, trace the stem shape onto stiff cardboard. Cut out and colour in.
- Cut into the square base so the stem can fold down under it.
- Colour the end of the cocktail stick to match the stem.
- Align the end of the cocktail stick with the stem so the rose petals rest on the square base.
- Tape the cocktail stick to the stem.

For the 'Glass' Cover:

- Using a nail or sharp point, pole a small hole in the centre of the glass base.
- Post the end of the fishing line through the hole and position the rose at the desired height.
- Tape the end of the fishing line to the top and trim. Or use a clear bead as an anchor to stop the line slipping back through.

VOILA! You have a beautiful Enchanted Rose.
